

## Swindon & District Directory Extract 1928 Hankerton



HANKERTON is a small village in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District of Malmesbury, and Diocese of Bristol, and is distant 4 miles from Minety and 4 from Malmesbury. The register of the Church of Holy Cross dates from 1699. The living, a vicarage net income £135, with residence, is in the gift of Mrs. Adkin. The principal landowners are the Earl of Suffolk and Berkshire (Lord of the Manor) and Mr. J. R. Randolph. Area, 2,203 acres; rateable value, £1,581; population in 1921, 243. Letters arrive from Swindon at 6.30 a.m., and are despatched at 3 p.m. and 8.10 p.m. Charlton, two miles distant, is the nearest Telegraph Office. CLOATLEY, half mile east, a tithing.
