Trial of Mary Golding and Elizabeth Woodward

Mary Golding and Elizabeth Woodward, both of Hankerton, were charged with damaging a fence. PC Maggs deposed that he was on duty on Tuesday, the 22nd October, in Mr Sisum's fields. He saw the two defendants pulling the hedge to pieces and damaging the trees.

Fined 3d and 7s costs each.

Mr Hardy, the magistrate's clerk, gave them his fees, and they were liberated on paying 2s 6d each.
