In the Name of God Amen. The Fourth Day of December 1711. I **Robert Causon** of Cloatly in the Parish of Hankerton in the County of Wilts being sick in Body but good and perfect memory thanks be to God and calling to Remembrance the certain Estate of this transitory Life and that all flesh must yield unto Death when it shall please God to call Do make ordain and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following revoking and by these Presents all and every Testaments and Wills heretofore by me made either by word or writing and my Body to be buried in such place where it shall please my Executor hereafter named to appoint

And now for the settling of my Temperall Estate and such Goods Chattles and Creditts as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I doe Order give and dispose of the same in manner and form following

First of all I give unto my Son **Edw. Causon** all my wearing clothes whatsoever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son **Edward** afores'd the sume of Twenty Shillings to be paid him by my Executor hereafter named within three months after my decease

Item I give unto my Daughter **Elizabeth Whittern** the sume of One Shilling and my Will is that she shall have the Four Shillings which I lent her when her Life was put in that House at Crudwell

Item I give unto my Grand Daughter **Elizabeth Parsons** my best Pewter Platter

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter **Sarah Causon** all that my Bed and Bedstead together with all that belongs to the same bed whereon I lies


And all the rest of my household goods whatsoever I do give and bequeath unto my Daughters **Ann Farr** of Hampton and to my Daughter **Elionar Parsons** of Henly and to my Daughter **Sarah Causon** aforesaid and my Will is that the aforesaid household goods shall be equally divided between [^] and all the rest and residue of my Stock as goods and Chattles not herein before bequeathed after my debts Legacies and Funerall Expenses discharged I do give and bequeath unto my Son **Henry Causon** whom I do make my Sole and full Executor of this my last Will and Testament Revoking all other Wills and Testaments by [^] herebefore made
