HIGHWORTH & SWINDON UNION

The Board of Guardians of this Union hereby give Notice, that they will, at their Meeting, to be held at the Workhouse at Highworth, on Wednesday the 20th day of June next, receive Tenders from persons willing to supply the Workhouse, and Poor of the Union, with BREAD and FLOUR, (best seconds) from the 24th June instant, up to and inclusive of the 29th September next.

The Bread and Flour to be delivered at such times and places, and in such quantities, as the Board of Guardians, or their Officers, shall direct.

It is competent for any person to tender for either of the undermentioned Districts of the Union, separately:

DISTRICT No. 1, Containing the parishes of Blunsdon St. Andrew, Castle Eaton, Hannington, Highworth, Inglesham, Rodborne Cheney, Stanton Fitzwarren, and Stratton St. Margaret.

DISTRICT No. 2, Bishopstone, Chiseldon, Draycot Foliat, Liddington, Hinton Parva, Swindon, Wanborough, and Wroughton.

Security will be required for the performance of the Contracts. By order of the Board.
