

## Post Office Directory Extract 1875 **Heddington**



**Heddington** is a parish in the Northern division of the county, Calne hundred, union and county court district, diocese of Salisbury, archdeaconry of Wilts, and rural deanery of Avebury, 3 miles south from Calne, and 5 north from Devizes.

The church of St Andrew is a stone structure, consisting of chancel, nave, north aisle, with a square embattled tower surmounted by pinnacles. The register dates from 1538. The living is a rectory, yearly value £239, with residence, in the gift of, and held by, the Rev. Francis Houssemayne Du Boulay, M.A., of Exeter College, Oxford.

Here is a National school; also a place of worship for Wesleyans. The charities are £18 yearly.

Near Heddington is supposed to have been a Roman station, as coins have been found in the ruins of ancient buildings in the vicinity.

The principal landed proprietors are Major Spicer and Isaac Clark, esq.

The soil is clay; subsoil, chalk. The chief crops are corn and pasture.

The area is 1,686 acres; rateable value, £2,841 8s 9d; and the population in 1871 was 360.
