Heytesbury 1850-1899

1878

Warminster Petty Sessions, Thursday. Enos Poole and Emma Louisa Poole were charged with being drunk and disorderly at Heytesbury on the 21st of June. P.C. Clarke proved the case. Superintendent Pierce said that the man had been convicted several times before, but it was the woman's first appearance before magistrates. The male defendant was fined 10s and costs, or in default 14 days, while the woman was discharged on payment of costs. Western Gazette, Friday 19 July 1878
