Híghworth 1850-1899

1871

Inquest before Mr. Coroner Whitmarsh. At the Golden Lion, Rose Lane, in the parish of Highworth, on the body of a new-born female child, two days old, whose mother came from service at Oxford, and was confined at her married sister's house, without medical assistance. The mother found the child dead on her arm. Verdict - Accidently overlain. Western Daily Press, 1 July 1871
