In 1831 Highworth had 130 houses with 123 inhabited; about one-sixth of the population was agricultural and there were 124 families. In 1833 it had one infant school with 50 children; 4 day schools with 117 boys and 42 girls; 3 Sunday schools with 223 boys and 194 girls.
