Hill Deverill

HILL DEVERILL is a parish in the Hundred of Heytesbury, Warminster Union, South Wilts, 3 ¼ miles south from Warminster, 117¼ from London, and 4 west-south-west from Heytesbury. The living is a perpetual curacy, in the presentation of - Elliott, Esq. of Torquay, Devon. The church was rebuilt in 1842 by subscription. The Duke of Somerset is lord of the manor. Population, in 1851, 122; acres, 1,735; rateable value, £3,204.

RAY HILL is 2 miles west.
