Weavers

Listed Grade II of architectural or historic interest, Weavers was originally two dwellings which were sympathetically joined to create the current attached house. Weavers was probably rebuilt in the 18th century and displays much essential character with exposed timbers and a stone fireplace in the sitting room now housing a wood burning stove.

Also downstairs is a dining room and the drawing room has an open fire. There are some attractive woodblock floors downstairs. The well fitted kitchen overlooks the pretty enclosed rear garden from which there is access to a pedestrian path leading to the high street and village shop. There are three good sized bedrooms and a bathroom on the first floor as well as superb storage. There is an excellent built in wardrobe in the main bedroom and two large cupboards on the landing. There is also loft space above the bathroom. A staircase leads up to the second floor which has been arranged as a separate bedroom suite with a roll top bath and adjoining cloakroom.

Hindon is arguably one of the prettiest of the Nadder Valley villages and is situated a mile or so south of the A303 amid beautiful rolling countryside.

The surrounding countryside, much of which is designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, is ideal for walking and riding.

Two parking spaces and a good sized garage lie to one side of the house and the garden is enclosed by hedges and fencing. There is a secluded paved terrace beside the kitchen and a further terrace set in the lawn is overlooked by a pretty summerhouse.
