Henry William Cool enlisted at Andover, Hants with the Hampshire Regiment. He was given the rank of Private & a service number of 201145. His place of residence was listed as Tangle, Hants.	
It appears that Henry's birth may have been recorded as Henry William Cole in the district of Alderbury (of which Odstock is a parish), Wiltshire in the March quarter of 1892). Henry's parents were married at St Mary's Church, Odstock on 7 Decemeber 1889.
