Other Significant Information

Lewis Vincent enlisted at Devizes, Wiltshire with Royal Warwickshire Regiment. He was given the rank of Private & a service number of 28602.

John Vincent & Maria Dukes had Banns of Marriage December 1877. They had a son Lewis who was baptised 8 Jan 1882 at Hindon, and was buried 18 April 1883 at Hindon, aged 1 year.

James Vincent & Alice Hacker were married at Hindon 26 March 1878.

The 1881 census shows that James & Alice [buried 1 Aug 1885 at Hindon] lived at Vincent's Buildings, Fonthill Gifford. Children were Frederick, Lucy. All were born at Fonthill Gifford.

James Vincent and Mary Wilkins were married June Qtr 1886.
