Other Significant Information

Parents were married in St. John the Baptist Church, Hindon, Wiltshire in 1884

Sidney George Phillips enlisted at Market House, Salisbury with Wiltshire Regiment on 6th December, 1915. He was given the rank of Private & a service number of 23737. Sidney Phillips' Attestation Paper states he was aged 28 years & 10 months, from High Street, Hindon, Wiltshire. His occupation was Steersman (Traction Engine) & his next-of-kin was listed as his father – Mr William Phillips. His religion was Church of England.

Pte Phillips embarked from Devonport on 18th September, 1916 with Mediterranean Expeditionary Force & disembarked at Basra on 15th October, 1916.
