Parents were George Goodfellow and & Ann Ford who marries at Chilmark 10 March 1866.	
The "UK Soldiers Died in The Great War" lists that Private Thomas Charles, 30505, of Royal Warwickshire Regiment was "formerly 31612, Worcs. Regt." However the WW1 Service Medal & Award Rolls lists Pte Goodfellow, 30505, 1/6 Battalion, Royal Warwickshire Regiment as previously with 11 <sup>th</sup> Battalion Shropshire Light Infantry with a service number of 265015. The Medal Index card lists Pte Thomas C. Goodfellow originally with Shropshire Light Infantry, service number 265015, then transferred to Labour Corps with a service number of 30505.	
Thomas C. married Gertrude Nellie Lawes at Coombe Bissett on 15 June 1912.	
Thomas Charles Goodfellow enlisted at Salisbury with the British Army, and lived in Hindon, Wilts.
