Ames	James	<p style="text-align: center;">In testimony of respect to the Memory of JAMES AMES ESQR. many years the kind and active Surgeon of this Town who with the benevolence worthy of a man and a Christian by his last Will bequeathed A service of Sacramental Plate to this Chapel and Ten Pounds annually to the Poor This Tablet is erected By the Grateful Inhabitants of Hindon He died at Bath June 9<sup>th</sup> 1828 aged 71 years</p>
Harding	Francis	<p style="text-align: center;">Sacred To the Memory of FRANCIS HARDING, who died Novr. 20<sup>th</sup> 1806, Aged 35 Years Also to JOHN HARDING his son, who died Novr. 10<sup>th</sup> 1808, Aged 15 Months. Inter'd in the same grave are the remains of JAMES HARDING CANDY, who died Decr. 15<sup>th</sup> 1813, Aged 16 Years. A striking example of early piety.</p>

Harding	Francis	<p style="text-align: center;">In a vault in the aisle of this Church are deposited the remains of <b>FRANCIS HARDING</b> who died on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September 1862, Aged 81 Years also of RUTH his wife who died on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Jany. 1868, Aged 74 Years also of AUGUSTUS HENRY second son of ERASTUS and ANNE SOPHIA HARDING who died on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of December 1865, Aged 11 Years.</p>
Lawford	Thomas	<p style="text-align: center;">Sacred to the Memory of THOMAS LAWFORD ESQ: of this Parish who died 15<sup>th</sup> August 1827, Aged 73 Years Also of KITTY LAWFORD Relict of the above who died 21<sup>st</sup> September 1835, Aged 73 Years.</p>
