WILTS LENT ASSIZES .

Anthony Cox, for burglary in the house of Robert Wiltshire, Holt, in the parish of Bradford, on 6th Dec [1831] and stealing a pair of stockings belonging to his son. The burglary was affected by taking out two large stones in the wall. Guilty. Sentence of death recorded. The Judge, however, intimated that the punishment would be lenient.
