### **Remand Home**

The Council propose to open shortly a new remand home at Holt, Wiltshire to accommodate up to 20 boys.

Applications are invited (i) from married couples for the post of Superintendent and Matron at salaries to be agreed, together with board and lodging and (ii) from single men for the post of Assistant Superintendent at a salary to be agreed, together with board and lodging.

It is desirable, but not essential, that the Superintendent should be a Certificated Teacher. The assistant should be able to assist the Superintendent generally and take an active part in the recreation of the boys and be able to teach handicraft subjects.

The appointment will be subject to the provisions of the Local Government Superannuation Act 1937, unless the persons appointed come within the provisions of the Teachers (Superannuation) Act, and will be subject to a medical examination.

Applications, stating, age, education, training, experience and salary required with copies of three recent testimonials must be sent to me not later than the 8th September 1941.
