

Holt World War I Casualty Biographies

HURN, Thomas Henry



Thomas Henry Hurn was born at Holt towards the end of 1899, the 2nd son and youngest of 5 children. His father, Henry John Hurn had also been born at Holt in 1864 and was a leather dresser at the skin works. His mother, Ellen had been born 5 years prior to Henry at Trowbridge.

Thomas enlisted at Devizes but little else is known of his military career. He was killed in action on 5th November 1918, aged 19.
