George Lewes Benson, L.L.B., one of the priest vicars of the Cathedral, and a surrogate of the diocese, has been conferred on the Rev. William Biscoe, M.A., incumbent of the adjoining parish of Coombe Bissett. The patrons are the Dean and Chapter of Salisbury Cathedral.
