1801

Thursday was married at Homington Church, Mr T Martin, jun. Of Odstock, near this city, to Miss B Perry, second daughter of Mr W. Perry of Homington.

1815

A few days since died Mrs Harwood, wife of Mr Robert Harwood, maltster, of Homington Salisbury and Winchester Journal 18 September 1815

1820

An inquest was held on Monday last, Homington, near this city, on the body of Mr Robert Harwood, a farmer and maltster that ... Salisbury and Winchester Journal 14 February 1820

1821

A few days since died, after a short illness, Mr. Ambrose Harwood, sen. Homington, near this city. Salisbury and Winchester Journal 20 August 1821

1825

Monday last at Homington, Mr Ambrose Harewood, brother Mr Harewood farmer that place, aged 31. Salisbury and Wiltshire Journal 26 May 1825

1834

Died, Oct 1, aged 7 years, Mary Jane, youngest daughter of Mr John Brown, of Homington, near this city. Salisbury and Winchester Journal 6 October 1834

Died on the 23 of October, Mary, wife of Mr Wm Harwood, of Homington, aged 63 years. Salisbury and Winchester Journal 3 November 1834

1838

July 29, aged 83, Mr Vincent, of Homington, near Salisbury. Wiltshire Independent 9 August 1838.

1839

Died at St Michael, Dorset, her ? year, Maria Millard, daughter of the late Mr R Harwood, Homington Salisbury and Winchester Journal 29 April, 1839

1845

Died. April 26, in Down Street, London, in her 60th year, Mrs Mary Manger, eldest daughter of the late Mr Ambrose of Homington, near this city. Salisbury and Winchester Journal 3 May 1845

1848

Died, April at Cashmore Inn, Dorset, after lingering illness, borne with Christian resignation, Elizabeth, the beloved wife of Mr John Rendell, daughter of the late Mr Harwood, Homington, Wilts, deeply and sincerely deplored by her family and friends, aged 56 years.
