In the name of God amen I Daniel Punter the Elder of Hullavington in County of Wilts yeoman being weake of body but of Good & perfect memory the Twenty Eighth day of Aprill in the first yeare of their Maties King William & Queen Marys Reigne over England etc. Anno Dom 1689 do make and ordaine this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say-

Imp I Give and bequeath unto my Son Daniell my best Coat & Breeches and my Best Hatt and to his Daughter Elizabeth I doe Give one yew and Lamb

I doe give unto my Daughter Emma Bleek the sum of one shilling and to her Eldest Son named John Bleek I doe Give the like sum of one shilling

I doe Give and bequeath unto my Son in Law John Hayward I doe Give ffive shillings and my daughter his wife ffive shilling more

Ffinally all other my Goods and Catle both with doore and without doore I doe Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth whome I make nominate & Apoint to be the sole and only Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament obleging her therewith to pay my debts Legacies and ffunerall Expences and makeing void all or any other will and Testaments by me made I doe publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament Witness my hand and seale hereunto the day and yeare first above written
