Give and bequeath to my beloved Son Lawrence Chandler And do make him sole Executor and residuary Legatee of this my last Will and Testament And I do revoke disannul and make void all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal upon the Seventh day of November in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and ffifty Seven <i>Wroughton Chandler</i>
