



## **Guilty of Stealing Bacon**

Wilts Michaelmas Sessions – Second Court

Frederick Munday, Edwin Munday, two young men and James Munday, a middle-aged man, father of the two former prisoners, were charged, the two sons with stealing 12 lbs of bacon, the property of John Nippard, at Idmiston, on the 18th Sept., and the father with receiving it, well knowing it had been stolen.

The two first-named pleaded guilty, the latter, not guilty. The jury found the prisoners guilty, and Frederick, having been previously convicted of felony, the court sentenced him to 3 months imprisonment, Edwin to 2 months, and the father to 3 months' imprisonment with hard labour.
