



Idmiston

Parish Register Notes 1629-1758

1629, 1st June

Alexander Geffard & Elizabeth Whithorne, both of "Idmiston within the precincts of Winterslow"

There is a detached portion of Idmiston parish called Shrippele in the middle of Winterslow parish

1642

None maryed at Idmiston, but diverse of the parishe married by Mr. Fox, curat at West Harnham

1648

There was non married in the parish this yere but diverse in other parishes.

1653/4, 13th March

Thomas Busterd, of Fiddleton parish, within this County, about the age of 30 yeaes, a widdower, & Elizabeth Rutter, a vergin, about the age of 26 years, were (this 13th day of March in the yeaer aboues'd) married and declared to be man & wife by John Rede, of Porton, esqr., one of the Justices of the Peace for County of Wilts. Witnessse my hand John Rede. The certificate thereof was attested upon oath by Robt. Shergold, parish Register. - The like is also attested by me, Andro London, parish Register of Idmiston

1653/4, 13th March

All the marriages from this date until the end of 1657, with one exception noted, were performed by John Rede, Esq.

1657, 2nd July

Henry Grey & Edith Sandall, both p. Dunhead St. Andrews, by John Sharpe ye younger

The above entry is out of order; it is written in a different hand and is the first entry since 1653 without "by John Rede, Esq." attached.

1758

"In the presence of William Porter and Isaac Mackrell, Stewards to the Lords and Ladies of the Manor of Idmaston."

This appears between the marriages dated 10 Oct and 10 Dec 1758. Cannot determine which marriage it belongs to perhaps it refers to all marriages between these dates.
