Mrs. Watts, of Whistley, near Devizes, left by will £100 to the Vicar and churchwardens of Keevil to keep in order certain family graves, £500 for the erection of a bell at the parish church at Keevil, and the residue of her estate to the Vicar and churchwardens of Keevil to found a "John Isaac Watts" fund for the benefit of poor persons over 55 years of age who have resided in Keevil for eighteen months.
