1786

Oliver Cromwell

Oliver born 1599. Protector 1653.

Oliver Cromwell was born at Huntingdon in 1599, of a good family – inheriting but a small estate, being the son of a second brother.

1658 ~ Cromwell declared Protector – and with much Solemnly installed into neat new office, unheard of before in this Island by an Instrument of Government prepared prepared for the purpose of this Instrument

It appears by the Ancient Register of Kilmington copied by – Chislet of Mere Wilts who went from thence in the Capacity of House Steward to serve James Grenville Esqr. of Butleigh in the Parish of Balsborough & who died in his service. I say by that Register it appeareth – that -

Edward Madox the son of Michael Madox the second – was baptised – the 26 of October – 1653 – the very year that Oliver got himself installed in the Protectorship.

Stephen Fox 1704

Stephen Fox Esq. Was born the 12 day of September Anno Domini 1704 at Chiswick in the County of Middlesex & was baptised the 17th.

He married Elizabeth only daughter and Heir of Thomas Strangways Horner of Mells in the County of Somerset, on the 15 day of March · 1735 · 6. He was created Earl of Ilchester a Baron of Woodford Strangways on the 11th day of May 1771.

He died much lamented by all who knew him at Melbury in Dorsetshire on the 26th day of September 1776, where he lyeth interred. On his monument is inscribed the following Epitaph, by The Rev. W. Ds. Dr. D.

Earl of Ilchester Ld Ilchester and Stavordale, Baron Strangways, of Woodford Strangways, Baron of Redlynch, a Lord of the Privy Council and Joint Comtroller of the Accounts of Army, was created Lord Ilchester in Somerset & Baron Strangways of Woodford Strangways in the County of Dorset . . . 11th . . . May . . . 174114th [year] of George the Second. And likewise Baron of Redlynch in the same County, with Remainder to the Right Honourable Henry Fox Esq., his only Brother (afterward Lord Holland) & His heir Male. January 3 174720th year of Geo "Reign



He was advanced to the Earldom of Ilchester on the <u>Seveneenth</u> of June 1756 – 29th yt of George the 2d, with like Limitation.

Christian Lady Fox, Second Wife of Sir Stephen Fox died 1718. She was a daughter of the Revd. Mr. Hope of Nasly in Lincolnshire.

Sir Stephen Fox died in 1716.

William Fox 1652

Mr. William Fox of Farley

Sir S. Foxs father departed this Life in 1652.

Mr. Fox afterward [?] was married to Mis Elizabth Whittle, Daughter of Mr. William Whittle of the County of Palatine of Lancaster.

In or before the year 1654 by this marriage he had six Sons and three daughters.

In 1703 having survived his children by the above Marriage – he spoused Christian Daughter of The Rev. Mr. Chas. Hope of Nasely in Lincolnshire, by whom he had two sons and two daughters.

Stephen . . . the late Earl of Ilchester

& Henry . . . Lord Holland. Grandfather to the present Lord Holland now at Eton School 1790 January 30

His daughter Charlotte – Sister to Ld Ilchester and Lord Holland married The Honourable Mr. Edwd. Digby second son of William Lord Digby, by whom she had 6 sons & 1 daughter – The other daught died in infancy.
