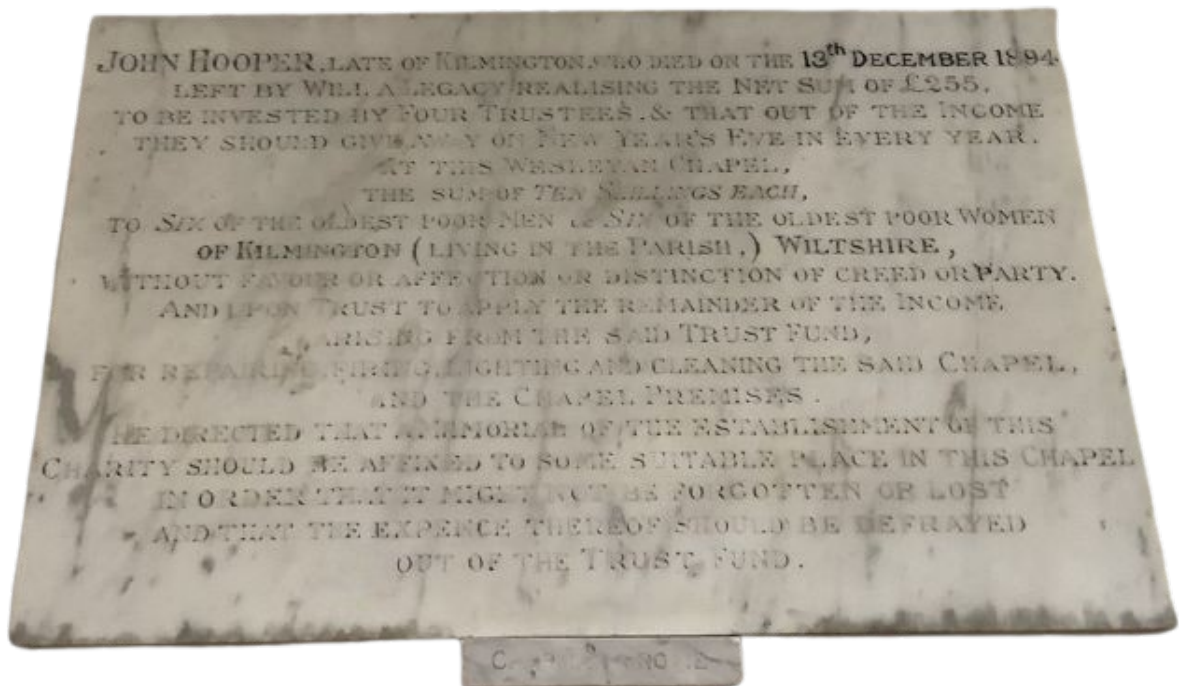


Kilmington
John Hooper
Benefaction Tablet 1894



John Hooper, late of Kilmington who died on the 13th December 1894
left by Will a legacy realising the net sum of £255,
to be invested by four trustees & that out of the income
they should give away on New Year's Eve in every year.
At this Wesleyan Chapel,
the sum of ten shillings each,
to six of the oldest poor men or six of the oldest poor women
of Kilmington (living in the parish) Wiltshire
without favour or affection or distinction of creed or party.
And upon trust to apply the remainder of the income
arising from the said Trust Fund
for repairing, firing, lighting and cleaning the said Chapel
and the Chapel premises.
He directed that a memoriam of the establishment of this
Charity should be affixed to some suitable place in this chapel
in order that it might not be forgotten or lost
and that the expence thereof should be drayed
out of the trust Fund.
