Inquests taken before Mr. Whitmarsh

At Lacock, on the body of Ellen Milsome, one year and eight months old. According to the mother's statement she left deceased in her bed between seven and eight o'clock, and was she supposed asleep. About half-past nine o'clock the same morning her daughter Rebecca brought the child down stairs to have it dressed, when she found it was dead. The medical gentleman who was called in deposed that he could not say whether the deceased had died from natural causes or otherwise, and the jury returned a verdict of "Found dead in bed."
