Back of north aisle wall:

- In memory of Robert COLBOURNE who died 19/4/1776 aged 67

Floor of north aisle:

- Richard son of Richard & Ann SPENCER who died 13/12/1801? Aged 20?
& Richard SPENCER who died 26/11/180? Aged 60? & Hannah SPENCER
Wife of above who died 22/5/1813? Aged 64?

- Illegible – William THRI?ORE? who died 7 or 17/2/?

Chancel north wall:

- Johannis TALBOT [further Latin text] born 7/6/1630 & died 13/3/1713

Chancel east wall left of Altar:

(Lower memorial)

- Horatia wife of Thomas GAINSFORD esquire & daughter of Admiral & Lady Elizabeth FEILDING died 8/8/1851 aged 41

Chancel east wall right of Altar:

(Lower memorial)

- Right Honourable Lady Elisabeth Theresa FEILDING eldest daughter of Henry Thomas [FOX-STRANGWAYS?] 2nd Earl of Ilchester born 16/11/1773, died 12/3/1846. First married 17/4/1796 William Davenport TALBOT of Lacock Abbey Esquire who died 30/7/1800 & second married 24/4/1804 Captain then Rear Admiral Charles FEILDING who died 2/9/1837

Chancel south wall:

- Chancel built 1777 & remodelled in 1902 in memory of William Henry Fox TALBOT, only child of William Davenport TALBOT born 11/2/1800 & died 17/9/1877

(Above the door)

- Mary Davenport wife of John SHAKESPEAR died 1793 aged 30 or 36? & John SHAKESPEAR died 10/1/1825 aged 74? & John Talbot SHAKESPEAR eldest son of above who died at sea on passage home from E. Indies 12 or 2 or 21?/4/1829? Aged -?9

Chancel south wall continued:

- Rear Admiral Charles FEILDING born 31/8/1780 & died 2/9/1837 lineally descended from Basil FEILDING 4th Earl of Denbigh of the House of Hapsburg & Count of the Holy Roman Empire.

(Brass tablet)

- Mary Spencer GROSETT wife of J.R.GROSETT Esquire MP died Lacock Abbey 31/12/1820 a few weeks after the birth of her stillborn child, and buried Bristol Cathedral, mother of 7 children.

(Lamp stand)

- In memory of Rosamond Constance TALBOT who died 7/5/1906

South Transept east wall:

- Captain Frederick William ROOKE RN of Lackham House in this parish who died 28/12/1855 aged 73

- Lady Ursula BAYNARD daughter of Sir Robert STAPILTON of Wychall (or Wyghall?) in county of Yorke, Knight & wife of Sir Robert BAYNARD, Knight who had Edward (buried here) & Mary died 1623 aged 36

- In memory of James MONTAGU esquire third son of Admiral John MONTAGU (commander of His Majesty's ship Montagu) who fell in action between Earl HOWE & the French fleet off Ushant 1/6/1794 aged 43 & buried at sea.

- James MONTAGU esquire & Diana (his wife), Edward their eldest son, James their second son & his wife Elizabeth daughter of Sir John EYLES Knight, Anthony their third son who died at Bengal India, & Robert their fourth son buried at St. Giles Middlesex

- 1727. Mrs Mary WROUGHTON spinster aged 64 born Wilcot, Wiltshire

- James MONTAGU esquire & wife Elinor daughter & heir of William HEDGES esquire of Aldrington, Wiltshire

- John MONTAGU esquire, Admiral of the White aged 76? Born Lackham 1719

- Colonel Edward MONTAGU fourth son of Admiral John MONTAGU aged 44 died of wounds May 1799 in India
- Edward BAINARDE esquire JP High Sheriff of Wiltshire died aged 63 21/12/1575

South transept south wall:
(BAYBARD Brass)

- 1501. Robert & Elisabeth (nee LUDLOW of Hill Deverill) of Lackham & 18 children. Philip eldest son, son George became a priest, daughter Jane married William TAMMS of Rood Ashton and was the mother of the last abbess of Lacock Abbey. The BAYNARDS came to Lackham in 1349. Edmund of Essex married Elinor daughter & heir of Sir John BLUET Lord of Lackham. The BAYNARD family line continued at Lackham for 10 generations until 1635 when Mary BAYNARD married Captain Honourable James MONTAGU

South transept west wall:

- Honourable James MONTAGU third son of Henry Earl of Manchester & Mary (wife) daughter & heir of Sir Robert BAYNARD of Lackham Knight. Issue – Walter, James, George, Robert, Henry, Edward, Sydney, Mary, Charles, William Katherine, Thomas, John. Walter died young, James married Diana daughter of Anthony HUNGERFORD esquire of Farly Castle Somerset, and Mary married Thomas EIDER of The Lee Hertfordshire esquire. James senior death age 57 and his wife Mary 63. James junior 38 at death with 4 sons Edward, James, Anthony & Robert

- Revd Archibald PARIS MA Rector of Ludgvan Cornwall who died at Bath 29/10/1861 buried Lansdowne cemetery & wife Caroline daughter of the late Revd Sir Henry Delves BROUGHTON Bart. Of Doddington Park Cheshire who died at Lackham House 28/7/1863 aged 43 & buried Lackham cemetery

Wall of south aisle:

- Barnard DICKINSON esquire of Bowden Park died 4/3/1814 aged 67
- Robert HELLIER died 9/4/1630 aged 63, one of His Majesty's criers of the courts of the common pleas in Westminster
- Charles WILLCOX son of William WILLCOX of Hazeland died 8/7/1680 & buried 10/7/1680. William WILLCOX son of William WILLCOX of Laycock died 29/4/1681 & buried 2/5/1681. Samson son of William WILLCOX died 2/4/1686? & William WILLCOX died 27?/4/1689
- Thomas COBBORN senior died 10/5/1700 aged 52 & Henry COLBORN senior dier [sic] who died 25/8/1733 aged 54 [and more illegible text]
- Mrs Sarah SKOTTOWE died 7/4/1821 widow of John SKOTTOWE esquire of Notton Lodge born St. Helena 28?/2/1774 married Sarah POLLOK daughter of Revd Thomas POLLOK LLD 19?/2/1799? Died 7/9/1820. Came from a long line of Norman ancestors. Only son Coulson SKOTTOWE born 18?/1/1800 and died Gratz Syria 13/1/1808

Floor of south aisle:

- Mrs Martina MORTIMER wife of John died 7/6/1808? Aged 68? John died ?/?/1807 aged 6-?
- John RICHARD who died 2/4/1757 aged 27
