### *Langley Burrell* *1800-1849*

#### **1841**

At a petty Sessions held at Warminster on Thursday last For Trial Hugh Nash, charged with having feloniously assaulted George Langley, and robbed him of one purse and thirty seven shillings, his monies at Langley Burrell. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 11 February 1841**

March, Salisbury Assizes Hugh Nash was indicted for having, in company with William Fry (not in custody), on the 20th January last, at Langley Burrell, assaulted and robbed George Langley of a purse containing a sovereign and silver. The jury found the prisoner guilty. A former conviction for felony was put in, and the Judge sentenced the prisoner to transportation for 15 years. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 8 March 1841**
