**1858**

County Petty Sessions      Assault      Mary Ann Tryhorn and Elizabeth Tryhorn were charged with assaulting a girl named Mary Ann Rebbeck, at Bishopsdown. Fined one shilling each and the costs. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 10 July 1858**

**1872**

County Petty Sessions – Tuesday.      Before Mr. J. Hussey, Mr. G. M. Fort, and Colonel Heathcote.  
A Negligent Driver.      The only case before this Court was that of a man named George England, a labourer, at Laverstock, who was charged with being found asleep, on the 18th inst., in a cart at Britford, while it was being drawn along the highway by an ass, and he was fined 5s. and costs, or seven days' imprisonment in default. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal and General Advertiser, 21 December 1872**
