

Commutatío n of Títhes Líddíngton 1838

I, the Undersigned, being duly authorised Agent of a Land owner or Land owners, within the parish of LIDDINGTON, in the county of Wilts, whose interest is not less than one fourth part of the whole value of the Lands subject to Tythes in the said parish, do by this notice in writing under my hand, call a PARACHIAL MEETING of Landowners and Tythe owners, within the limits of the said parish, for the purpose of making an agreement for the general COMMUTATION of TYTHES, within the limits of the said parish, pursuant to the provisions of an Act passed in the 6th and 7th years of the reign of his late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled "An Act for the Commutation of Tythes in England and Wales;" *And I do hereby also give Notice*, that such Meeting will be held at the House of Mr GEORGE BRIND, called the Parsonage, in the said parish, on SATURDAY the thirtieth day of June instant, 1838, at the hour of eleven in the forenoon.
