

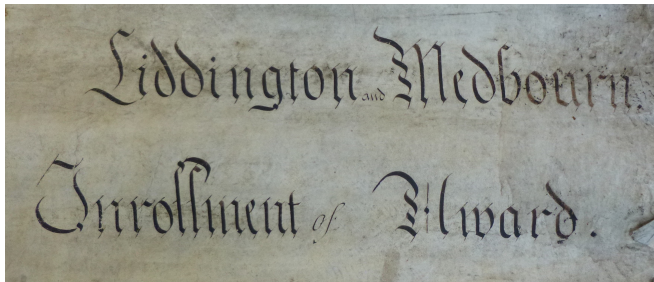

.... "Common Grounds and Commonable Lands within the Parish of Liddington and Hamlet of Medbourn in the said Parish of Liddington in the County of Wilts"

In Witness whereof We the said Francis Burton Hill Haggard and James Shipton the Commissioners aforesaid and also the said George Duke of Marlborough William Rich Stock and Thomas Hatt have hereunto set their hands and Seals the twenty seventh Day of February in the Seventeenth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith and so forth and in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven Hundred and Seventy Seven.
