LITTLETON DREW, or LITTLETON ST ANDREW, is a township, parish and village, distant 8 miles north-west of Chippenham, in Chippenham Hundred, and diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, North Wilts. The living is a rectory, value £200, in the gift of the Bishop of Gloucester; the Rev. C. Lawson is the Rector. The church is an ancient structure, with a tower containing 3 bells. The population, in 1851, was 237; the parish contains 971 acres of land, and 49 houses. The Duke of Beaufort is the lord of the manor.
