Thomas Snell pleaded guilty to stealing half a peck of bran, oats and chaff, value sixpence, the property of John Fitzherbert Jones, at Luckington. The prisoner who had been twice previously convicted, was sentenced to eight months hard labour. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 25** March 1858
