



Estate Sale

On Friday, at the Mart, a freehold estate in the parish of Ludgershall, on the turnpike-road from Andover to Devizes, was disposed of by auction, comprising the manor, extending over 1100 acres, two farms, and requisite buildings, cottages, gardens, and land, in all 595 acres, for 12,300/. The advowson and next presentation, the incumbent, aged 48, of the Rectory of Ludgershall; the tithes of 147 acres producing 330/. a year, and a house, stabling, carriage-house and other buildings for 2300/.
