



CORONERS INQUESTS



Joseph Hunt, 1837

An inquest was taken by Mr. Whitmarsh, during the past week, at Ludgershall, on the body of Joseph Hunt, who fell under the wheel of his cart, whilst endeavouring to get off for the purpose of walking up Shaw Hill.

He was severely injured in the head and survived two days.

Verdict - "Accidental;" Deodand 1s.
