Daniel Dobbs and William Cook, both of Ludgershall, labourers, charged with stealing a lamb belonging to Henry Pike, at Collingbourne Ducis, on the 17th November last.

The said Daniel Dobbs and William Cook are also charged with stealing a sheep belong to Jacob Crook at Ludgershall on 2nd December last.

The said Daniel Dobbs and William Cook are also charged with stealing a quantity of lead affixed to the parish church of Ludgershall, on the 24th June last.

George Lansley, of Ludgershall, labourer, an accessary, admitted as king's evidence against Dobbs and Cook, in the three charges above mentioned.
