1827

William Elkins, of Alderbury, and Richard Embling, of Lydiard Tregoze, for three months each, for breaches of the Game Laws. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 12 November 1827**

1833

William Odey, of Lydiard Tregoze, charged with having maliciously discharged a loaded gun, on the night of the 29th October at the window of the dwelling house of Robert Hiscock, at the above place. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 21 November 1833**

1843

Wilts Epiphany Sessions Benjamin Baker, charged with having stolen a quantity of potatoes, the property of the said Richard Henly, at Lydiard Tregoze. Guilty: 3 months imprisonment. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**
