Thomas Little

Inquests taken before Mr. Whitmarsh

At Chaddington Farm, in the parish of Lydiard Tregooze, on the body of Thomas Little, 72 years of age.

Mr. Daniel Ellison, of Cotmarsh Farm, stated that on Thursday morning last he found deceased lying dead on his face near a footpath leading from Broad Hinton, where he had been coming from to his home at Lydiard the previous evening.

He appeared to have died without a struggle. A hat was on his head, and a stick by his side.

Verdict, "Exhaustion and exposure to the cold."
