## Lydiard Millicent

Is in the Chippenham Division of Wiltshire, Cricklade and Wootton Bassett Union, County Court District of Swindon, Cricklade Petty Sessional Division and Diocese of Bristol, and is 3 miles from Wootton Bassett, 5 from Swindon, and 2 from Purton, the nearest Railway Station. The register of the Church of All Saints dates from 1697. The living, a rectory, in the gift of Pembroke College, is of the net value of £545. There is a Primitive Methodist Chapel, and one at Shaw. Area, 2,371 acres; rateable value, £4,863; population in 1921, 752. Letters arrive from Purton daily, and the post box closes at 6.15 a.m.
