Maiden Bradley

1842

The Rev. Charles William Fynes, M.A., Student of Christchurch, Has been nominated by the Dean and Chapter of that Cathedral to the Perpetual Curacy of Maiden Bradley, Wilts., (£112 per annum) void by the resignation of C. W. Knyvett, clerk, minor Canon of Windsor; and he has since been licensed to the name by the Lord Bishop of Salisbury. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 16 May 1842**
