



Malmesbury Market Day, 18th June 1890

There was a moderate supply of beef and mutton at our market today, and a small supply of pigs and calves. Prime beef sold fairly well. The trade was low for mutton. Calves were dear, but there was hardly any trade for pigs. Mr. W. Teagle sold 30 prime beasts, 300 sheep and lambs, besides calves and pigs. Messrs. Fielder, Rich & Son sold between 50 and 60 head of cattle, 150 sheep, pigs &c. Messrs. Moore and Hill sold about 20 head of cattle and 180 sheep
