<b>Remarks</b>	Eliza travelled out to New South Wales with her parents (Isaac and Elizabeth Macklin) and her siblings (Louisa, Emma, Jasper and Sarah).

**OPC Note:** On the 1841 census Eliza (aged 2) is recorded as living wither her parents (Isaac and Elizabeth Macklin) in Manningford Bohune. However, she is recorded with the first name Elizabeth, rather than Eliza.
