<b>Remarks</b>	Louisa travelled out to New South Wales with her parents (Isaac and Elizabeth Macklin) and her siblings (Eliza, Emma, Jasper and Sarah).

**OPC Note:** Although no baptism has yet been found, on the 1841 census Louisa (aged 6) is recorded as living with her parents (Isaac and Elizabeth Macklin) in Manningford Bohune.
