Remarks	Mary travelled out to New South Wales with her children (Henry John, Ellen and William). Mary gave birth to another child (Tory) during the voyage. Her husband Richard Osland had died in 1843.

OPC Note: Mary, the base born daughter of Ann Kimpston, was baptised at North Newnton on 14 April 1811. Ann Kimpston married Mary's father (Isaac Macklin) in 1813.
