Remarks	Tory was born was born during the voyage to New South Wales. Richard Osland, who had died of consumption in 1843, is incorrectly recorded as his father.

OPC Note: The birth of Isaac Tory Osland was registered shortly after the family's arrival in Australia. The father of Tory is not known but was most likely William Hawkins a widower living in Manningford Bohune.
