 the Sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds Now this
 Indenture witnesseth that in Consideration of the
 sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds by the said Alexander Grant
 Meek to the said George Lott paid at or immediately before the
 execution hereof (the receipt whereof the said George Lott doth hereby
 acknowledge) He the said George Lott doth hereby as beneficial
 owner grant and convey unto the said Alexander Grant Meek All
 that Dwellinghouse with the Buildings Garden and Appurtenances
 thereto belonging with the Piece of Land adjoining and occupied therewith
 containing in the whole by estimation one acre (more or less) late in the
 occupation of George Lott deceased and James Coles but now of
 Frank Whitmarsh And also all that Piece of Arable Land
 adjoining the last mentioned premises containing by estimation Two
 acres two roods (more or less) now in the occupation of the said George
 Lott All which said premises are situate at Manningford Bruce
 aforesaid and were formerly the Estate of the said George Lott
