Relatives in the Colony	Two brothers Isaac and John Roberts at Brownlow Mill.
Remarks	Matthew travelled out to New South Wales with his wife Elizabeth Roberts (nee Simper), a native of North Newnton, paying £1 for their passage.

**OPC Note:** Matthew Rabbits, the son of John (a labourer) and Anne Rabbits, had been baptised at Manningford Bruce on 4 December 1829.
