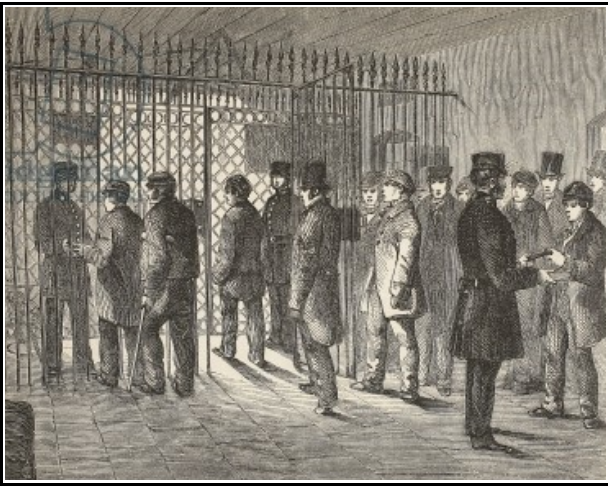


Crime and Punishment
